1.2 English, Environment & Biodiversity (Code HI 010)

This programme is designed, in partnership with the Irish National Biodiversity Data Centre (NBDC). It will comprise formal English classes plus escorted visits to mountains, forests, coastal habitats, peat bog and wildlife reserves. Students will collect biodiversity data and enter it on the national database.

Target group	EU and Irish teenagers over 15 years. Non-Irish students should have studied English for at least 3 years and have reached at least Intermediate level.
Date and Duration	Date : Mid-July Duration: 2 weeks
Activities and outings (evenings and weekends)	This group will join other Hello Ireland groups for evening and weekend activities and outings.
Accommodation and catering	Full Board. Most students stay in Student Apartments. A small number of homestays can be organised on request.
